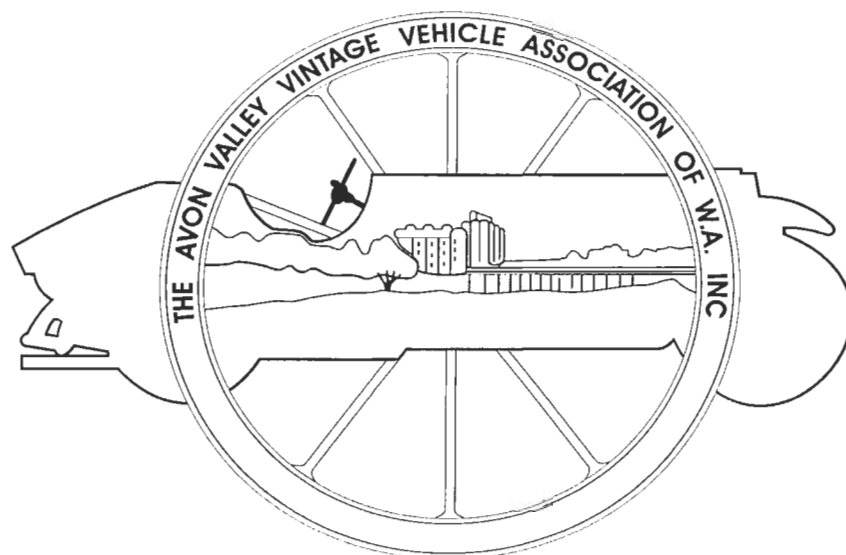

A three-jeep SAS patrol, North Africa, 1942. The SAS, raised by Major David Stirling in November 1941 as 'L Detachment of the Special Air Service Brigade', was used principally for deep-penetration raids on enemy airfields and rear-area installations. Wearing Arab head-dress and invariably bearded, the men traversed the desert in specially-converted jeeps or trucks, well-protected by machine guns.

# THE PAT KERR MEMORIAL NATIONAL VETERAN VEHICLE RALLY BUSSELTON 2007

**Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> to Friday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2007**  
**Conducted by the Veteran Section on Behalf of**  
**the VCC of WA (Inc)**

**The Pat Kerr Memorial National Veteran Vehicle Rally is named in honour of the late Pat Kerr, one of the foundation members and a Life Member of the Veteran Car Club of WA, and a founding member and stalwart of the Veteran Section. He will be remembered for running many Rallies of the VCC, not least of which was the last TAVCCA rally held in WA.**

This Rally is the first **Veteran only** National Rally to be held in WA. Prior to this year Vintage vehicles were invited to take part to boost the number of participants but it is now considered that there is a sufficient number of Veteran vehicles in this State for them to run alone. This brings WA into line with other member States of the Association, who run Veteran only National Rallies. (A veteran vehicle is a vehicle built prior to 31 December 1918.)

From information and Expressions of Interest already received, it is anticipated that more than 60 veteran vehicles will participate.

**The rally will take the form of a "Hub" rally whereby vehicles will travel to a different scenic destination each day, returning to Busselton each night. The Busselton Branch of the VCC have kindly invited us to use their facilities as our headquarters for the Rally and our start point each day will be at their clubrooms.**

The Event commences on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> March when the entrants are expected to arrive in Busselton, settle in to their respective accommodation facilities, and then attend a briefing session/welcome/sausage sizzle in the late afternoon/evening at the Busselton Branch clubrooms. The rally proper will take place on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Wednesday will be a lay day with vehicles on display, with the opportunity for participants to join an excursion to some of the many vineyards and/or other attractions the region can offer.

A Rally Dinner will be held on Friday evening and this will bring to a conclusion the formal part of the Rally. Participants are free to do their own thing on Saturday. Different routes will be available each day for slower and faster vehicles; however, the

lunch destination will be the same for both groups. For the slower vehicles, total daily distances should not exceed 70 kilometers.

Lunch each day will be at a winery or restaurant where entrants will have a choice of meals at prevailing prices.

Accommodation has been already booked in Busselton for known participants and several rooms are currently yet to be placed. These will be allocated on a first come first served basis. As accommodation is in demand we cannot hold these rooms for much longer and prospective entrants who have not yet expressed interest should do so as soon as possible.

Entries for the rally close on 12 January 2007.
