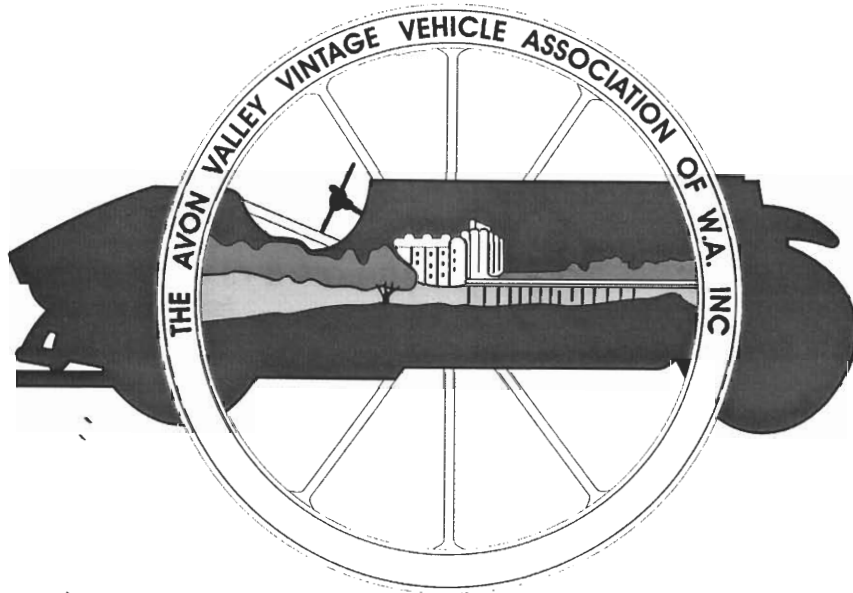

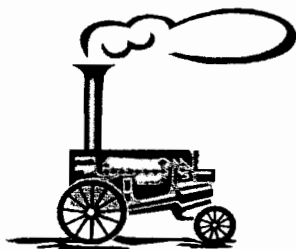

### **Shed Report:**

Truck tyre purchased for Ford truck. Reimbursement of \$170 given to John King. He also advised he sold three second hand tyres for \$80 and presented cheque for one trailer rental (\$25).

Bob Thornton's donation of 1971 Rover vehicle was discussed by all in attendance. John King queried why we should be considering selling it as it was a donated item and possibly could be used. Letter from estate executor was read to members, whereby the family advised the club, that the vehicle was donated to the club and the club could make any decision in regards to the retention or subsequent sale, i.e. there was no requirement that the club keep the vehicle. Members suggested the vehicle be reassembled, cleaned up, and then make a decision to either keep and fully restore or sell. Vehicle was not to be re-registered under full registration. It was suggested that the club begin a collection based on a selection of technology eg 1900's, 1910, 1920, 1930, and 1940 and so on. Current club vehicles are 28 Harley M/Cycle, 49 Ford, 54 Morris, 54 Zeta, 65 Sprite.

Allan Hicks suggested that the 2 stationery engines be removed from shed and put under display. Phil commented that the magnetos would probably be stolen and difficult to replace. Allan suggested they go on display in the shed. Andrew Wooding suggested magnetos be removed prior to display. Jim Donovan advised some club shirts have arrived. Cost @ \$35.00 each. Lyle Metcalf to be reimbursed.

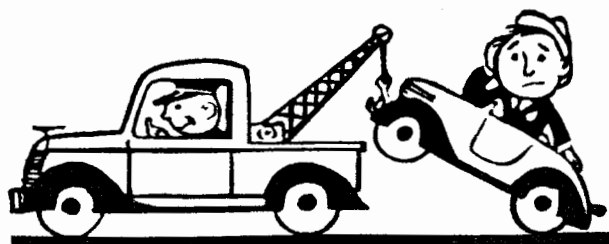

# REX DOWNIE

Club member, Rex Downie, is interested in 1920's and 1930's vehicles and has seven restored and a further five "projects" underway. A walk around his workshop sees a 1912 Talbot, an REO truck and an International truck coming together and a 1929 Chandler nearing completion.

Outside, past a two door "A" model Ford waiting to come into the workshop to start restoration, is the main garage, which houses a 1929 Marquette in original condition, as well as a 1925 Talbot, 1926 DeSoto, 1927 Dodge "Fast" 4, 1922 Citroen, 1927 Oakland and a beautiful 1922 Minerva. The garage is also home to "T" and "A" model Fords. The collection includes a Harley Davidson and a very early belt drive BSA motor bike.

Looking at the walls of the workshop, it is obvious that Rex's other passion is collecting number plates from Western Australian Shires with over 200 on display.

Rex has been an active club member for around 15 years. Club participation has included a spell as Vice President, many years organizing the club's annual Swap Meet and he is currently on the Committee for this year's event. Rex and his wife Chris regularly attend those Club functions that are suited to Rex's older vehicles.

In their spare time, Rex and Chris continue to maintain their historic home and surrounding buildings at Katrine.
